ANC3C RESOLUTION NO. 2008-022

Resolution Approving Grant for John Eaton School for expenses associated with the school play

WHEREAS the John Eaton Home and School Association submitted a grant proposal to ANC 3C at its March 2008 public meeting;

WHEREAS the John Eaton Home and School Association grant proposal seeks \$1000 to help defray the expenses of the annual school musical;

WHEREAS the John Eaton Home and School Association after-school activity attracts approximately 60 students from grades 4 through 6 and allows them to experience on-stage performing as well as technical and backstage activities;

WHEREAS the John Eaton Elementary School draws students from nearly every ward in the city; and

WHEREAS the John Eaton Home and School Association grant proposal provides that Kim Bayliss, representative of the Home and School Association, will accept the grant proceeds and will be responsible for the accounting of the grant funds pursuant to DC law and the rules established by the DC Auditor:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that ANC 3C approves the grant of \$1000 to the John Eaton Home and School Association for the 2008 school musical; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chair, the Treasurer, or their designee is authorized to represent the Commission on this matter.
